
How To Join Adsense

To start making money with Adsense, you first need to have an Adsense affiliate account. If you already have one then you can skip this part and move onto part 2.

You need to go to https://www.google.com/adsense/g-app-single-1?destination=/adsense/home and fill in all the information required.

TIP:


When you enter the URL of your primary site, you will stand more of a chance getting accepted if it is a professional looking established site with no advertising on it. Google doesn't look favorably on accepting sites that look like they have just been put up to get accepted. Therefore, already having ads on it is a big no-no.

Niche Research


There are lots of ways to find niches for Adsense sites. You can just look around you and see products that people want to buy. Think of what current hot products or topics are at the moment that people are talking about or that people want.

If you can't think of anything, there are a few places you can go that might help:

<u>http://pulse.ebay.co.uk/</u> - Like Google, this one tells you the hottest products on eBay.




Keyword Research

There are both free and paid ways of doing this. Paid ways are normally quicker but I am just going to cover the free ways at the moment. First you can use the free Google keyword tool here:

TIP:

Make sure you click on options and set the territory to the correct one you are trying to target, i.e. USA, UK or Entire World and so on.

Enter your seed keyword into the keyword box and click search. Enter the capture if required. You will get a list of keywords. On the left hand side, untick Broad and click on Exact – this will give you a more accurate result of what is being searched for.

Domain Name and Hosting

Domain Names

You will need a domain name and hosting if you don't already have it. There are 2 domain name sites that I use and am pleased with:

Hosting

For hosting, there are lots of different companies but one I recommend is Hostgator. Their baby account is only \$9.95 per month for unlimited sites and, if you sign up using this coupon, you get the first month for only 1c. http://vreempiremonthly.com/Recommends/Hostgator

Building site

There are lots of ways to build a site, but the cheapest way is to use WordPress. It is free and easy to install.

If you have hosting from companies that have Cpanel, like Hostgator, then you can use a program called Fantastico De Luxe. With a few button clicks, in less than 5mins you will have WordPress installed.



Then you just need to get a theme. There are lots of free themes available depending on the niche you are interested in. Just do a Google search for "Free WordPress Themes".

Once you have installed your theme, you need to add some plugins. I recommend you get ones for Adsense, Sitemap, and SEO. Here is a list of plugins I recommend. These are all free:

- Addthis
- all-in-one-Adsense-and-ypn
- evermore
- Google-sitemap-generator
- Privacy-Policy
- WP-contact-form

TIP: If you have Adsense on a site, you must include contact details and a Privacy Policy that covers Adsense

After the plugins you need content. This can be obtained in different ways. The best way is unique content. The cheapest way is to write them yourself. They don't have to be long. Approximately 300 words per post will do fine. The easiest way is to outsource and pay someone else to write them for you, but this will set you back about \$5-\$10 per article.

The other option is PLR. You can get this for free if you search on Google, but you will need to rewrite some of it to make it more unique. Otherwise, the search engines won't like it.

The last way is article directories. All article directories will allow you to publish their articles on your site as long as you don't change the content. This is an easy way to get content, but there will be lots of sites showing the same content. However, you can use this as filler content to add to your unique content so you don't need to write as much yourself.

Getting Traffic to Site

There are lots of free methods. Again, the paying ones are easier, but I want to concentrate on the free ones in this report.

First, make sure you have a sitemap generator plugin and that you submit the sitemap to Google. In that way, every time you publish a new article, Google is alerted and updates its searches with the new information. Also, a good way to get Google interested in your site is to drip feed the articles. For example, if you have 10 articles to add to site, put 5 up straight away and then add the extra 5 to be drip fed every 3-4 days. It will appear that you are adding new content regularly, which Google likes.

As it is a WordPress blog, you automatically have an RSS feed created for you, which is a great way to promote the site. There are lots of site where you can submit your details and get your feeds pinged by the search engines. Following are some good ones:

Another way is by writing articles and having them submitted to article directories. This gets you backlinks that search engines like, but also links back to your site that humans will like as well!

Here is a list of the top Article Directories:

There are many more to choose from, but if you stick to these 3, you won't go wrong.

Another way is video marketing. All you need is a short video of 30 seconds-2 minutes with a link back to your site. You can upload it to YouTube for free, and this is a great way to get traffic to your site. Also, you can do social bookmarking with places like Digg, Delicious, Stumbleupon and others.

Conclusion

Good money can be made from Adsense, if you do it right. You can start making money using the free methods listed here. Once you start making money, you can buy tools that will help you expand your Adsense empire further and pay to outsource your article writing and promotion. Good luck with your online business!
