The energy that flows down a street is relentless and quickly becomes overwhelming to someone living in its path.





NUMBER TWO FEATURE: NEIGHBORS

Select a home that has houses or open spaces for neighbors. Do NOT select a house that is across the street from a cemetery. Dead people do not make good neighbors. Yes, they're quiet, but their energy is dead. You need living energy.

Choose a house that is not across the street from a hospital. Hospitals are full of sick people. People are dying to get out of there. This is not the kind of energy you want to live next door to.

Don't choose a house across the street from a church or a school either. Although there are weddings in church, there are funerals too. You don't need a hearse in your front yard! Schools are full of too much energy. Given the choice, you don't want all that energy coming through your yard.



NUMBER THREE FEATURE: FIRST IMPRESSIONS

Choose a house that has a wonderfully welcoming entrance. The driveway and front walkway should be gently curved, as should the gardens out front. No straight lines aiming at your door!!

The door should be visible from the entrance to your property. The entry area should be open, well lit, and secure. It should not be difficult to find or provide a place for burglars to hide.

The doorbell should be easy to find. Make certain the doorbell looks like a doorbell and the door's hardware is in good working order.

Be sure there are no wasp's nests around the door or plants with thorns or sharp points. There should be nothing dead at the door or anywhere in the front yard or property. If there are weeds, trash, or anything indicating neglect, this is NOT where you want to live.

NUMBER FOUR FEATURE: KILLER VIEWS

Open the front door and step into the house you are considering making your home. If you can see straight through the entire house and out the back, turn around and leave. This is not the house for you.

One of the primary objectives of the principles of good feng shui is to bring energy in the front door and get it to meander gently around the house, staying a while before it leaves.

A house with a killer view - energy rushing from the front door out the back of the house - will cause you to starve for energy. There will be severe financial distress here, even bankruptcy. Rushing energy will also bring on unexpected medical emergencies just like living at the end of a cul-de-sac.

This is NOT where you want to live.




Whether you have a double door entry or a single, long hall foyer, if the view is all the way through the house you will struggle. You must hang curtains or put items between the door and the window to slow the energy flow and get it to stay a while.

I know you love the light and the view. Of course you do. It's like loving being in the sun. The sun keeps you warm and tans your skin (and brown fat is much more attractive than white fat!)

NUMBER FIVE FEATURE: SQUARE FOOTPRINTS

Look for a house that is designed to have a square or rectangular footprint. Avoid a house shaped like an L, T, H, or U. These homes are missing major areas of energy that you need to live a happy, healthy, safe and comfortable life. See the Bagua Energy Map on the next page to see which area of energy you will lose in such a home.

All these areas of energy are interconnected. You cannot have a good Marriage if you don't have Knowledge of yourself. Likewise, you cannot have Wealth without Benefactors. If your Reputation is gone, your Career is going to flounder. If your Family is fighting, your Children aren't happy.

Especially avoid a house on a property that is shaped like a meat cleaver or a boot.



NUMBER SIX FEATURE: MASTER THE BEDROOMS


Master bedrooms should be sited past the midline of the house. The front half of the house is much more public than private.

Everyone will sleep better out of the public area, away from so much energy. They'll also sleep better if they are not in a bedroom over the garage.

Choose a house that has the master bedroom in the back left or right quadrant of the house. Back center is way too much energy too, although this is a good place for a family room.


Avoid a house with the master bedroom overlooking the front yard, driveway or street. This is NOT where you want to live.



Make sure your master bedroom sits snug and happy in the castle keep - away from the public area of the house.

The Ten Best Feng Shui Features to Look for In a Home

NUMBER SEVEN FEATURE: HEART OF THE HOUSE

Look at what sits in the exact center of the house, from front to back, and right to left. Make absolutely certain you do not find a fireplace, stove, or toilet there.

These features can be a little further back or to the left or right of perfect center, but when they are found DEAD CENTER the energy of the house converts to deadly whenever they are used.


You also do not want to be able to see the stove, fireplace, or toilet from any entry door. This is way too public a positioning of very private features for your home. This is NOT where you want to live.

NUMBER EIGHT FEATURE: BATHROOM BLOW-OUT!

Bathrooms have only been indoor features for part of the last 100 years. Bathrooms in the back right corner of the master bedroom will take all the romance right out of your Marriage.

Yes, you can do your business behind closed doors, but eventually someone has to open it to go in or come out. The smells associated with bathrooms are not sensual or attractive. Neither are the sounds.

While you *have* to have a bathroom in or next to the master bedroom, having one in the back right corner - from standing in the bedroom door - is very difficult to counter-balance. Try to find a master bedroom with the bathroom in a different location. This is NOT where you want to live.



NUMBER NINE FEATURE: KITCHEN SECRETS

Avoid houses with the kitchen sited as the first room you see when you walk in the door. You'll gain a ton of weight!!

Avoid houses with the stove right next to the refrigerator or the sink. You'll heat up what you pay to cool!

Try to find a house that has the stove situated so that the cook can see what is going on around her but not so the stove top is on an island. It's just too dangerous to mix children running through narrow walkways and hot pots with handles.

It's best to have a window or open view above the sink, but never have a window over the stove. It makes your private life way too public. This is NOT where you want to live.


Left: Stove next to sink - not good.


NUMBER TEN FEATURE: WATER FEATURES

If you're lucky enough to find a home that has outdoor water features, your life will be truly enhanced. Humans need water to live and almost all of us choose to go to the water for any given vacation. So let's look at the good feng shui details.

If you have a pool in the back yard, it's best if it's in the back left corner of the property (from the mouth of the driveway). You want it to be shaped to embrace the house. And you want any fountain or spray it may have set up to pour *towards* the house.

If you have a fountain or pool in the front yard you want it to be in the front center area of the yard (to the right of the door as seen from the street).

If the pool is in the back center or right area, add lots and lots and lots of plants around it - in the ground and especially some in pots!

Make sure your water feature pours water *towards* the house or sends the water straight up then recycles.



Above: water embraces house, but also vanishes. Choose no vanishing water.



Left: water vanishes from pool - not good.



Above: water pours away from the house - not good.



Left: pool in back left area of property. Diving board brings energy back towards house - much better.


